TECHNICAL SHEET:

- Language: local language and English
- Target audience: children, families and students
- Size: 500 sqm
(the exhibition can be expanded/reduced to fit in to larger/smaller halls)
- Minimum ceiling height: 4 m
- Installation / dismantling period: 15 working days

CODICE. IDEE PER LA CULTURA WILL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING TO THE HOST VENUE:

- Open files for sceneries, backdrops, and structures for the 12 sections in the language requested;
- Open files for 10 interactive exhibits and hands-on (technical equipment such as PC, projectors, media players has to be rent on site by the hosting venue based on the technical rider provided by Codice);
- A series of approximately 20 short films and audio stories specifically realized for the exhibition;
- Suggestions for educational activities;
- Codice installation team to supervise and adapt the project / assist installation and dismantling;
- Instructions for day-to-day supervision;

The exhibition may be enriched by original specimen. Codice can provide on request a list of specimen and support the hosting venue in the loan procedures form local, national and international museums (please notice that minimum notice for loan requests to museums is 12 months).

HOST VENUE WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING:

- Facility report on controlled environment, safety, structure and accessibility in the host venue;
- Transportation costs of the materials and liability insurance on the materials
- Travel costs of the Codice installation team to supervise and assist installation and dismantling;
- Skilled support staff to assist with installation and dismantling, including a site manager and an electrician;
- Translation of text for panels, digital interactives, etc. into the venue's desired language;
- Construction of scenarios, backdrops and structures;
- Electrical supply;
- Exhibition lighting;
- Audio-visual support;
- Promotion and publicity;
- The exhibition must be under surveillance at all times.
